Annual School District Goals (111)

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education recognizes the value of the goal setting process for school improvement. Therefore, goals shall be established annually by the Board of Education and district administration to provide direction for school district action.

Annual school district goals will be established by a committee created by the District Administrator. A list of goals will be created by the committee and sent to the Board of Education for adoption by no later than August of the fiscal school year. Upon completion of the goal setting process, an action plan and timetable shall be developed by the District Administrator to facilitate successful completion of the annual school district goals. Annual school district goals will be monitored and adjusted, if necessary, throughout the school year.
