Curriculum and Parents Rights (332)

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District recognizes the right of parents to inspect certain instructional materials and to deny their child's participation in certain curricular activities in accordance with state and federal laws and regulations.

Complaints resulting from the denial of parent's requests regarding the inspection of certain instructional materials and/or a child's exclusion from participation in certain curricular activities shall be made in writing to the Building Principal. The parent can appeal the Building Principal's decision to the District Administrator. All complaints will be judged individually.
