## **Reading Instruction (341.1)**

The Board supports the following reading goals for the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District:

- ➤ A well-coordinated developmental reading program shall be made available for students at all grade levels.
- ➤ A variety of learning materials and teaching techniques shall be used to accommodate individual student ability and achievement levels.
- ➤ Each teacher must recognize the role of reading in his/her content area. The teacher is responsible for continuous diagnosis and motivation in his/her classroom or content area.
- A climate for reading will be established within the school that will encourage and develop a lifelong desire and willingness to read.
- ➤ Efforts will be made to gain parental and community involvement in district-wide concern for quality and quantity of reading.
- > Students who qualify will receive Title I reading services by appropriate staff as required by law.
- > Students will be expected to meet the academic standards for reading that have been approved by the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education.

The reading program shall be evaluated annually by the Building Principals, District Administration and the Board of Education in accordance with state law.
