Student Policies Goals – 410

Full Time Students (412.1)

All Students are considered full time students if the following condition exists:

- 1) Elementary school students must be scheduled for the full school day.
- 2) High school students must be scheduled for a number of periods equal to the total number of periods in the school day. Students who leave school for work experience are considered full time students so long as their work experience is part of the district approved school-to-work program. Seniors who qualify for senior privilege and can miss one period per school day (Periods I or VIII) will also be considered full time students as long as they qualify for senior privilege under established Brookwood High School procedures.
- 3) Exceptions may be made for students identified with disabilities.
- 4) All students of Brookwood Jr. and Sr. High School are considered to be in attendance the entire day when they have been in classes for 62.5% of the entire day (5 of 8 periods). All students will be considered in school for half a day when they are in attendance between 12.5% to 62.4% of the entire day (2 periods to less than 5 periods). Students absent the first two periods of the day will be considered tardy.
