School Admissions (420)

Any student seeking entrance into the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District must reside within the established boundaries of the district, except as otherwise allowed by state law.

Building Principals shall have the authority to determine the grade level at which the student shall be placed. Students transferring into the district shall provide academic transcripts and discipline records from any previous school, or the address from which this data may be secured. If adequate academic transfer information is not available, the Building Principal may require the student to take appropriate academic tests to assist in making placement.

Parents or guardians of students admitted to the districts elementary and secondary schools shall present immunizations records as required by law.

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District shall not discriminate on admissions to its schools on the basis of sex, race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap.
