Tobacco Use By Students (443.3)

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Elementary School along with Brookwood Jr. and Sr. High School are tobacco free facilities. All students are prohibited from consuming or being in possession of any tobacco products, including e-cigarettes, while attending school, while being on school property, while attending or participating in school sponsored events, or while riding on district owned transportation. Students who violate this policy may be subject to disciplinary measures.

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education recognizes that it has a responsibility in educating students regarding the effects of tobacco use. Tobacco education is integrated into the curriculum, where appropriate, with the aid of health teachers, guidance counselors, knowledgeable others, and outside professionals and consultants as available.
