Emergency Nursing Services (453.1)

The purpose of emergency nursing services is the maintenance of the physical, mental, and emotional health of students while they are at school or participating in school activities. The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education provides for emergency nursing services to be available to school district students four days per week. All health services in the school will be under the supervision of a registered nurse either hired by the school district or contracted out from another organization by the school district.

A designated health area within the school building will be equipped with the supplies necessary to provide emergency care in accordance with standards set by the Department of Public Instruction and the Department of Health and Family Services. Procedures for dealing with accidental injury, illness, and medication will be established annually by the school nurse. In the case that the school nurse is absent on a given day, staff members trained as emergency medics will be contacted to handle emergency situations.

A record system shall be maintained in the district, including accident reports and a log of services performed. Confidentiality of records shall be maintained in accordance with state and federal laws and regulations.
