#### **School Safety Intervention Teams (727)**

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District will have an established School Safety Intervention Team (SSIT). Members of this team will consist of:

- All School District Administrators.
- At least one Local Law Enforcement Officer.
- All staff trained in the Department of Justice Threat Assessment Protocol.
- At least two staff members (1 Elementary, 1 Jr. & Sr. High School) who have received 12 hours of Adolescent Mental Health Training.

The School Safety Intervention Team will use and follow the Wisconsin Threat Assessment Protocol. It will meet a minimum of two times annually, more than that if administration believes circumstances require it. Meetings will be held in the Jr. & Sr. High School Office Large Conference Room or Jr. & Sr. High School LMC. The Agenda for these meetings will consist of, but not be limited to the following:

- Organize and Plan School Safety Training for new staff.
- Discuss any prohibited or concerning behaviors from students, parents or staff.
- Review and if need be revise communication and reporting protocol.
- Discuss the role of law enforcement within the school and law enforcement interventions.
- Develop, review and revise assessment procedures and assessment options.
- Review risk management options.
- Promotion of safe school climates.
